Short presentation of the organisation

Jarina Association Bohinj was established in 1993 in the core municipality of Triglav National Park as a nongovernmental or non-profit organisation. Activities are focused on preserving natural and cultural heritage of the Alpine area, like

- raising awareness for culture and nature values,
- renovation of cultural heritage of national and European importance,
- promotion of Slovenian mile-stone art and artists, especially those connected with mountains
- establishing and strengthen connections between nature conservation and social activities of different stakeholders in the alpine area, especially in the Natura 2000 sites and network
- common and intensive in-the-field communication with stakeholders on local levels.
- Jarina Association and its sections are known as a NGO that is mostly involved into complex projects.

Association is well known by their experiences in the field of nature conservation, communication with stakeholders, tight co-operation with Triglav National Park Authority and local communities in many past projects, and especially common presence in the area of National Park.

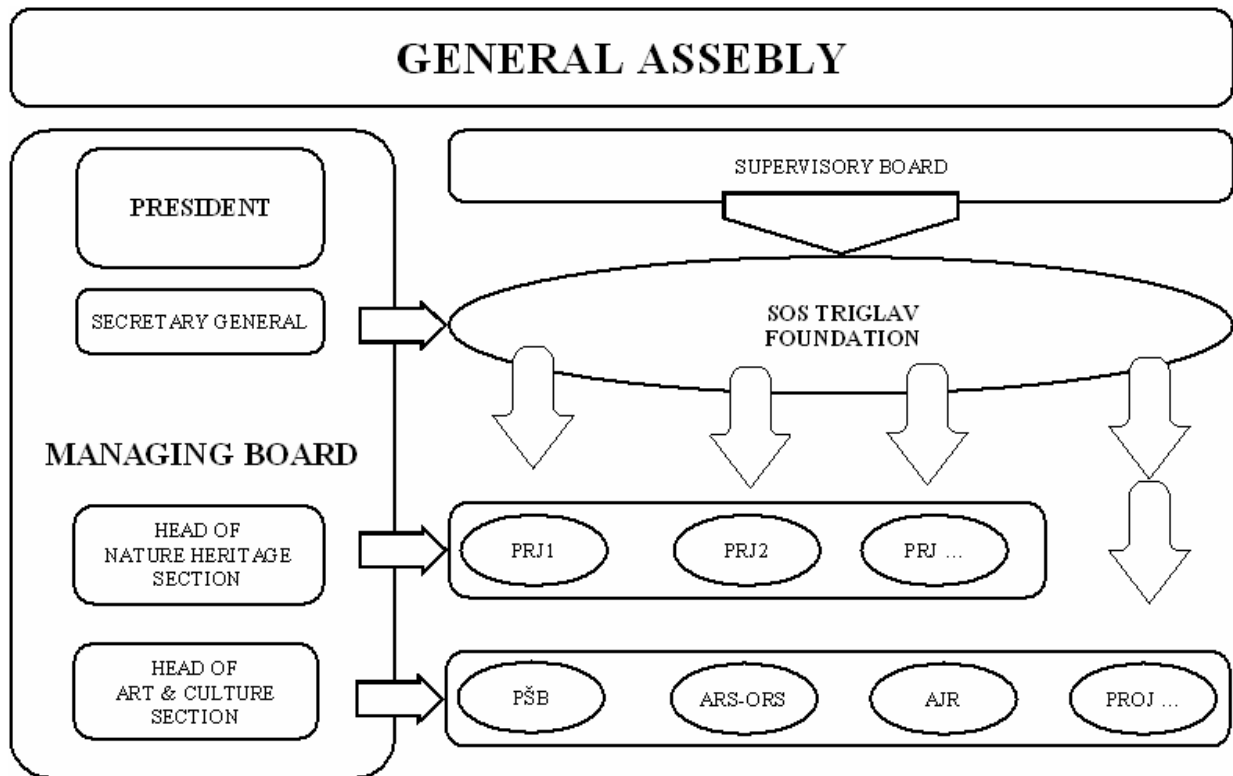
SOS Triglav Foundation was founded 1999 **as a section** of Jarina Association. Evident needs for supporting different and complex activities in the field of nature and culture heritage preservation have been recognized on one side, and donators were willing to support *specific* tasks and actions clearly defined in our long- and mid-term programmes. There were some discussions and tendency during past ten years to set foundation apart from Association, especially because of changing tax regulatives on a state level. Until now the effects of work seemd to be more fruitful in a form of united human and financial resources. But future is still opened.

Commonly used abbreviation "SOS" derives from a scream Save Our Souls. You can understand it as a consequence of past and present threats to nature and people in our peripheral homeland - and, at the same time, a fright of an uncertain future because of lower level of GDP, mobility problems, emigrations - especially young educated persons and families.

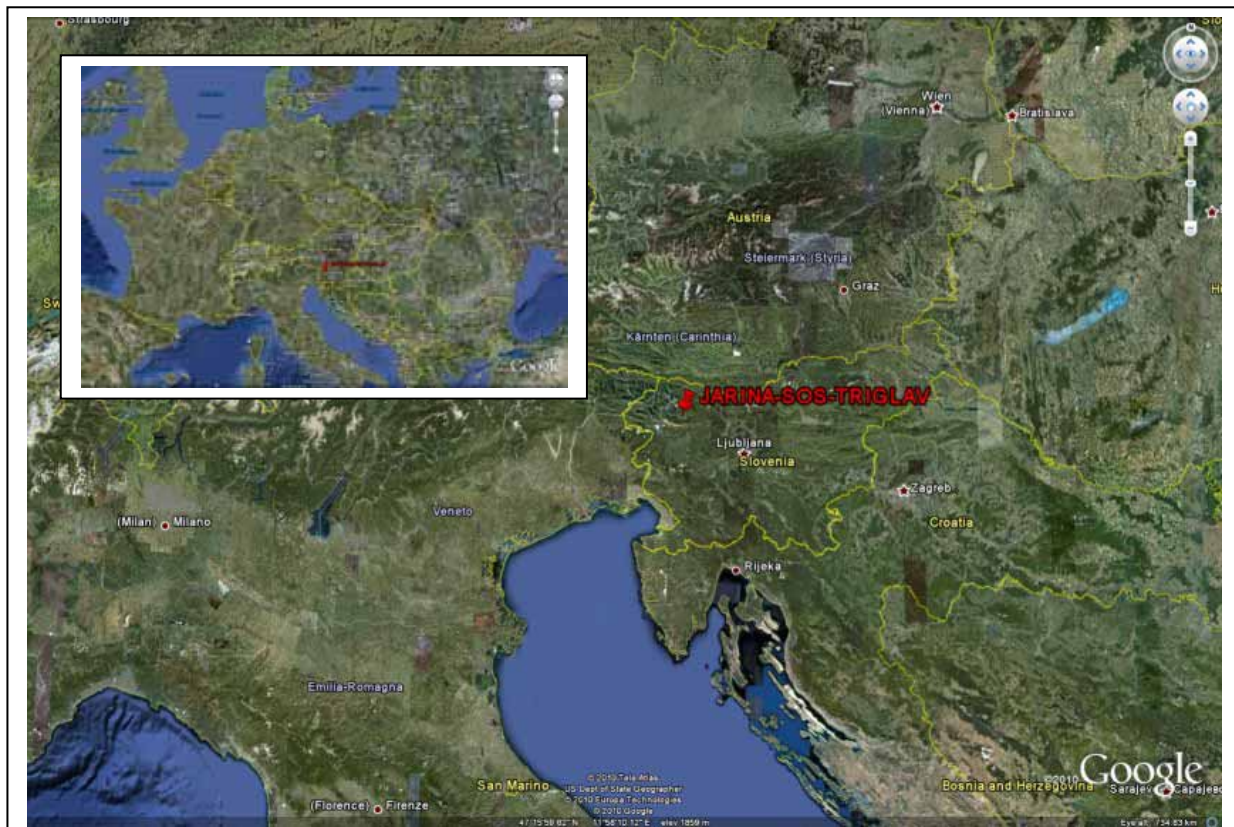
But abbreviation SOS in our case actually represents *abbreviation* in Slovenian language: **Sklad za Okoljske Sanacije** - in free translation: Foundation for Environmental Sanitation. Abbreviation significantly represent goals of the Foundation: to support field actions and to promote intellectual as well as spiritual activities of human that will lead us to better understanding, higher awareness and deeper respect of nature and cultural environment. Results of those activities represent a grounding for in-the-field actions.

With actions allready implemented (see the list below) we approved that many successful projects may not only give fruitful direct results to the society, but even stimulate other stakeholders to follow ideas, to work better and more sustainable for nature and people well-being.
